Guidelines to consider when planning your improvement or change:

- Diggers Hotline must be contacted when shrubs or trees will be planted. Contact them either online <a href="http://www.ne-diggers.com/Locate/Homeowners.aspx">http://www.ne-diggers.com/Locate/Homeowners.aspx</a> or by calling 402 344-3565 to submit a request.
- O When planning landscaping changes, you must consider the mature size of the shrubs and trees. If the mature tree/shrub will hang into your neighbor's lot, the planting must be adjusted. Also, allow enough space between the mature planting and your home. Planting too close to the home may impair painting of the home.
- Covenants do not allow fencing of any kind.
- Underground sprinklers may be impacted with landscape changes. All costs are the homeowner's responsibility. Any architectural changes made without verifying the location of underground sprinklers that result in damage to the sprinkler system are the homeowner's responsibility.
